5. Share in a small group. No critiquing - just listening.

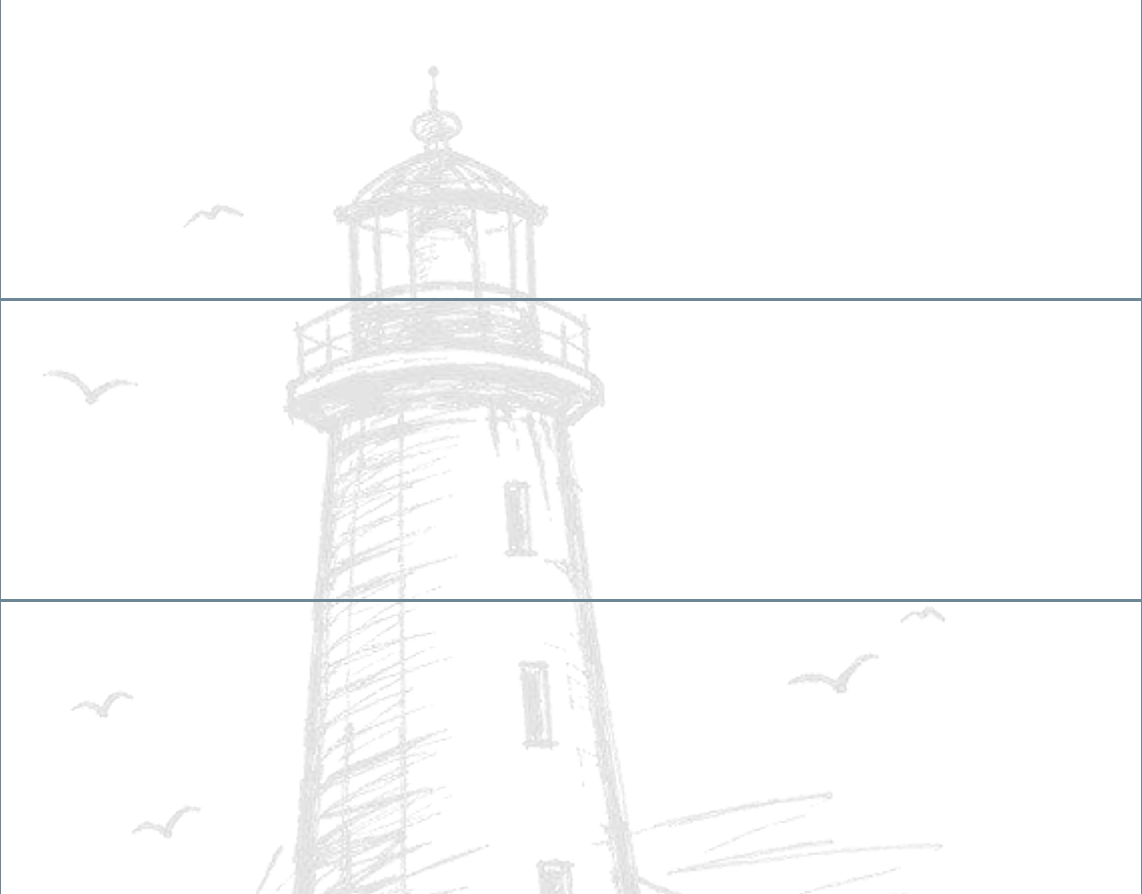
Think about it: Was anything surprising? Did the patterns match what you expected?
