PROMPT 2B • FOUNDATION VALUES

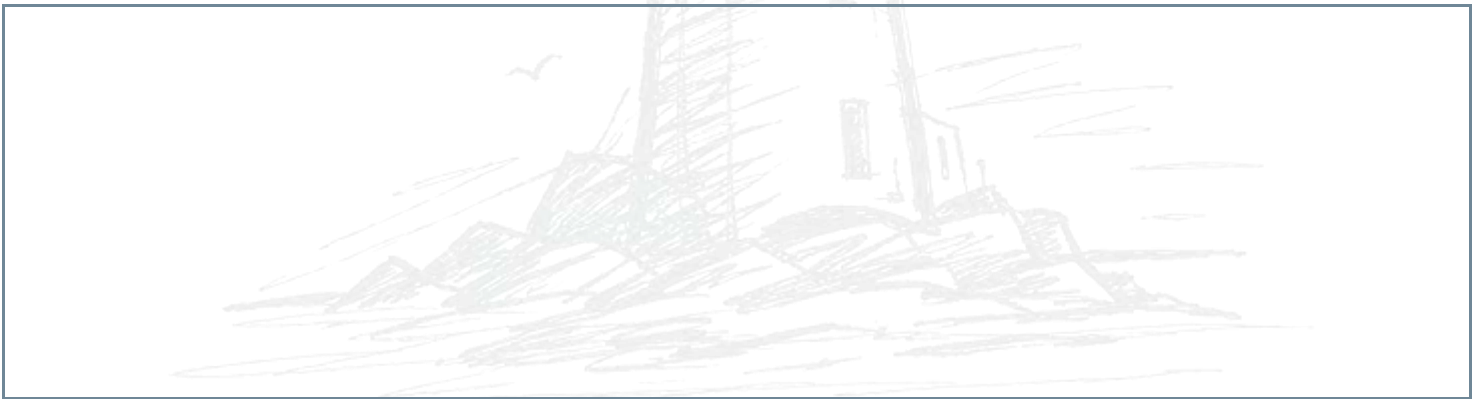
The Beacon Keepers choose integrity, respect, and connection as their foundation values.
