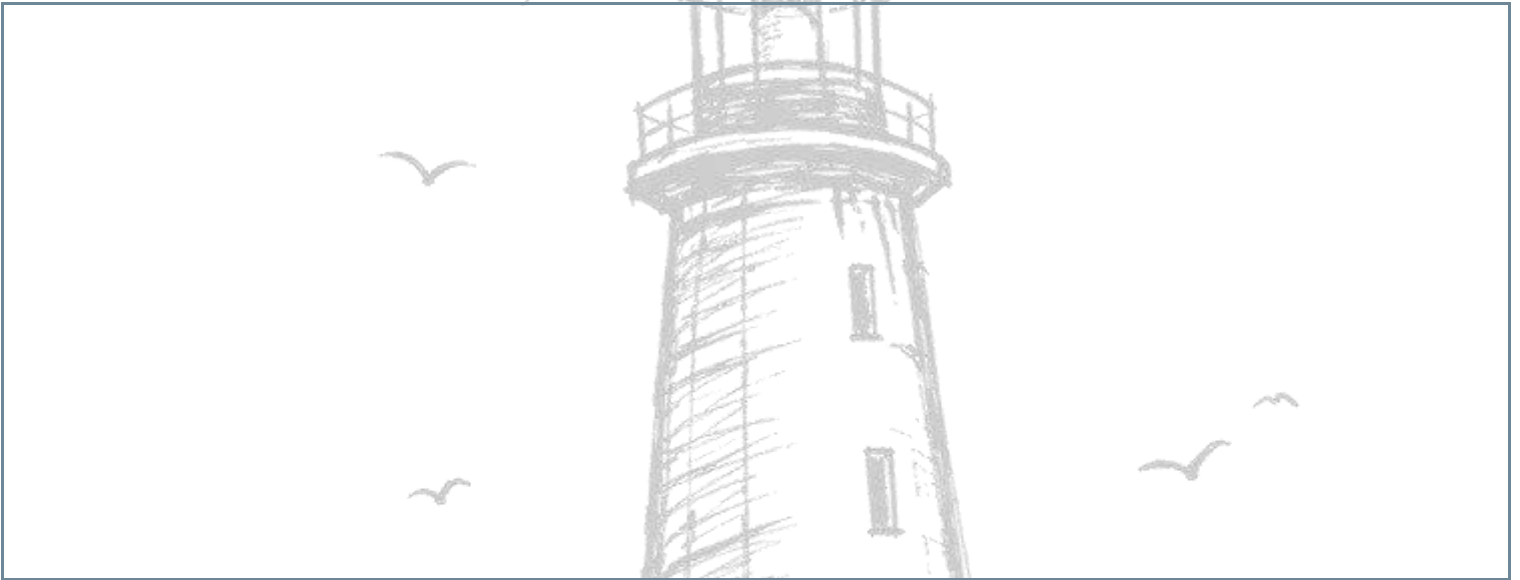

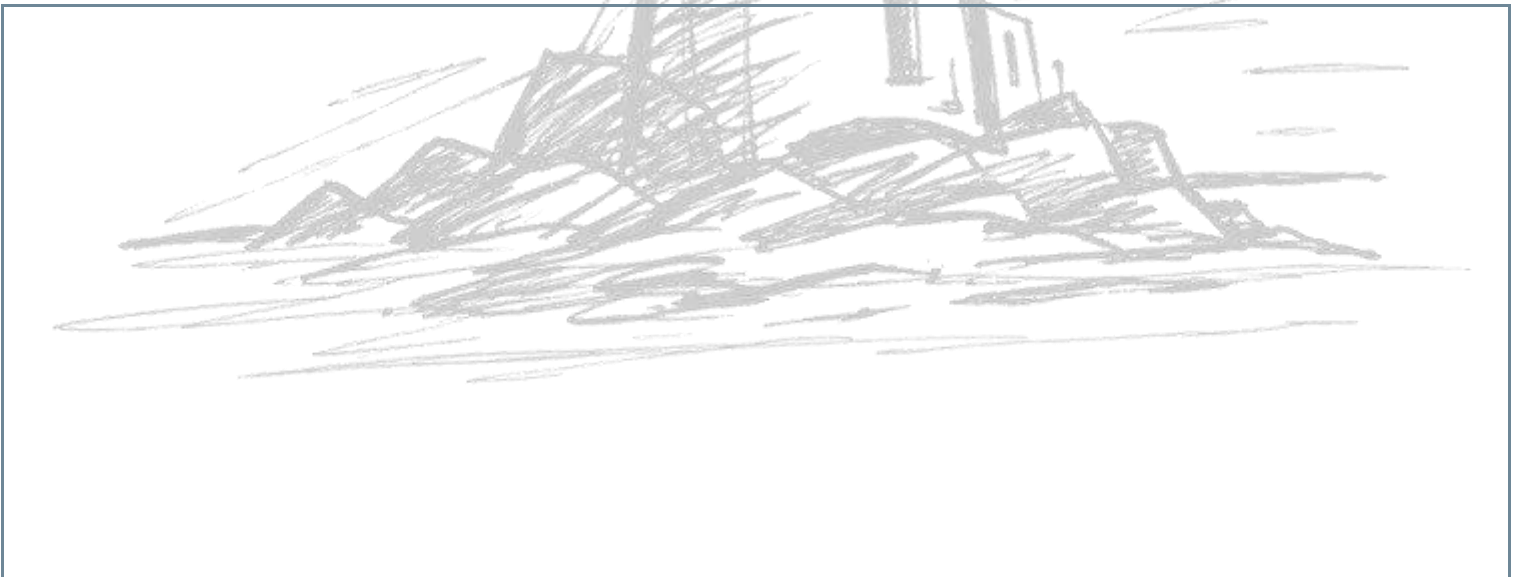
3A • TALK ABOUT IT

2. Is there a difference between protecting a friend and helping a friend?



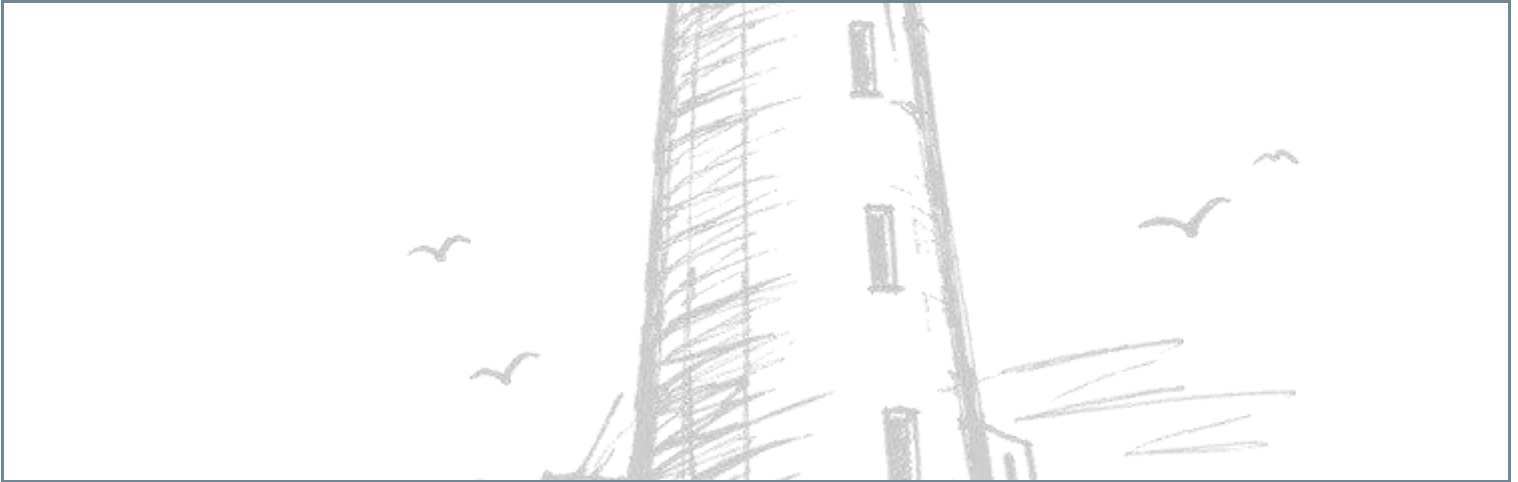
3B · TALK ABOUT IT
